Note: Hindi or English must be one of the two languages to be studied in class XI and XII. Hindi and English can also be offered simultaneously. In Hindi and English, two courses have been provided for class XI and XII and the student may either opt Hindi Elective or Hindi Core and English Elective or English Core. However, the same language cannot be offered both at core and elective levels.

In addition to the above, the following combinations cannot be taken together:

- Business Studies and Business Administration
- Out of Computer Science/ IT related subjects, i.e. Computer Science and Information Technology, a candidate can opt for only one subject
- Mathematics and Applied Mathematics

Note: The subject combination shall be permitted as per its availability in the opted school.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Candidate shall be eligible for admission in Class XI as per the following criteria:-

- 1. If he / she has passed Class X Examination from Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi or any other Recognized Board or it's equivalent Exam recognized by C.B.S.E.
- 2. If he/she has been declared 'Pass' by the respective Board.
- 3. If he/she has not Passed higher examination or equivalent from any other recognized Board/University.
- 4. Any Candidate placed under compartment in Class X shall be admitted provisionally to class XI till he/she passes the first chance compartment exam. His / Her admission shall be cancelled if he/she fails to pass the same.

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

- 1. Registration Form is to be filled online on the website of Education Department i.e. www.chdeducation.gov.in.
- 2. Registration form shall be accepted online with Registration Fee of Rs. 150/- only to be paid online.
- 3. There is only one Registration Form for all the streams (Science, Commerce, Humanities Or Skill Courses) and hence only one Registration Form is to be filled up by the candidate seeking admission to Class XI in any Govt. School.
- 4. Candidates can fill up online form from their respective schools from where they've appeared for Class X under guidance of the available faculty from 09:00 am to 01:00 pm on all working days. Staff will guide the students in online filling and submission of Admission Form.
- 5. In case of any problem in filling the form, the candidate can also take help of NIELIT, Sector 30, Chandigarh from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM on any working day. Before visit, the students can seek appointment from NIELIT Centre

on 0172-2650121 and visit the same as per time slot given to them.

- 6. After filling in basic details by the candidate, a unique ID and password shall be generated, which the candidate shall have to keep safe for the future reference.
- 7. Candidate shall have to login again using ID and Password generated for filling-in the Registration Form.
- 8. In case a student has passed the Secondary School Examination from board other than CBSE, he/she is required to submit a scanned copy of Detailed Marks Certificate of Class X. Class X CBSE students (pass out of year 2022) are not required to attach the scanned copy of Detailed Marks Certificate.
- 9. Candidates who have passed i. Compartment Exam ii. X Class exam in any year except 2022 are required to submit a scanned copy of their Detailed Marks Certificate with the Registration Form.
- 10. Further, the candidates who belong to any reserved category would also have to submit a scanned copy of the relevant

document/ certificate claiming admission against the reserved seat. (Sports/SC/Physically Challenged/Defence or Paramilitary/Freedom Fighters' Children or Grandchildren/Kashmiri Migrant). The benefit of reservation would be given only if the candidate uploads a scanned copy of the relevant certificate.

- 11. After submission of the Registration Fee of Rs 150/-, the candidate is required to take a print out of the submitted form.
- 12. The print out of the submitted Registration Form is to be retained by the candidate for its submission at the time of admission in the school, where the candidate shall be allotted a seat.
- 13. Any claim of the candidate pertaining to the marks / caste / category shall not be entertained in the absence of uploading scanned copies of the relevant documents as mentioned at Points 8,9 and 10 above.
- 14. Particulars/details filled online by the candidate as on the closing date/time shall be considered final and preparation of merit and allotment of seat shall be finalized on the basis of these details.



PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST

1. Common merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in Class X in the following 5 subjects:

English, Mathematics, Social Sciences, General Science and Language II.

- In case the candidate had opted 2. for more than one language (in addition to English) in Class X examination, the language in which the candidate has secured higher marks will be considered in lieu of Language - II). In case, Language - II is not offered by School Board, marks obtained by the candidate in any other subject will be considered. In case of Open School Exam, marks in any 5 subject on the basis of which the candidate has been declared successful, shall be considered.
- (I) If two or more candidates are having same total, than a candidate getting higher marks as mentioned under "1st Tie" will rank higher in order of merit.
- (ii) If two or more candidates are having same marks as mentioned

COVID appropriate behaviour should be maintained at all times.

under "1st Tie" then the candidates having higher marks as mentioned under "Subsequent Tie" will rank higher in order of merit.

- (iii) If two or more candidates are having same marks, under 1st Tie and subsequent Tie, the candidates having higher age shall rank higher in order of merit.
- 3. Common Merit list (Before "Tie break") prepared as per above criteria and other particulars will be uploaded on the website (Date to be announced after declaration of result by CBSE) www.chdeducation.gov.in.

Candidate may check his /her status in the merit, other particulars such as category, gender, preference of school and stream.

4. In case there is any discrepancy/objection, the candidate shall submit the same through email on a specified proforma. For this purpose, the candidate has to log in with his ID and password. The students can also seek telephonic help from helpline numbers as mentioned at Page No 20.

The detailed instructions regarding fee payment and verification of documents shall be notified later on.

ALLOTMENT OF SCHOOL/STREAM

- Seats will be allotted on basis of

 (a) Position in Common Merit list after deciding "Tie" points.
 - (b) Order of preference of school and stream given by the candidate.
 - (c) Availability of seats in a particular school.
- 2. A Candidate will be admitted in one school and in one stream only.
- 3. List indicating the allotment of school and stream will be uploaded on the website. Names of all those candidates who have been allotted seats in various school shall be included in this list.

Deposit of Fee

- 1. The candidates will have to take a print out of the Admission Form after logging in with his/her ID and password. This form, duly signed by the candidate and the parents has to be submitted along with the already filled in Registration Form in the school where the candidate has been allotted a seat.
- 2. The detailed instructions to deposit fee and verification of documents in the school where the candidate has been allotted a seat shall be notified later on along with display of merit list.

COVID appropriate behavior should always be maintained in the school.

General Instructions

- 1. Admission can be refused to any candidate on valid reasons.
- 2. Admission to all the students will be provisional till the verification of Marks Sheet and other relevant documents by the school allocated to him / her.
- 3. Admission will be confirmed only on production of documents, including migration certificate (wherever applicable).
 - (a) All Foreign/Overseas students are required to produce student visa / Residential Permit. Applicants with other types of Visas will not be considered for admission.
 - (b) Eligibility Certificate from the CBSE must be furnished by all foreign students without which application for admission of foreign students will not be considered. Director School Education, Chd. Administration is also authorised to issue Eligibility Certificate.
- 4. No Candidate shall be allowed to change his/her subjects of study after Second Counselling.
- 5. Physical Education as an elective or addl. subject or in lieu of lang-ll will be offered only if a student fulfils the conditions laid in Senior School Curriculum 2022-23 of CBSE, New Delhi.

Note: In case a candidate fails to deposit the fee by the scheduled date, the candidate shall be barred and his form shall not be considered further for admission.

General Conduct Rules...



- 1. Students must abide by the conduct rules and regulations of the school. There are solely designed to safeguard the welfare of the students and may be changed without any prior notice. The students are advised to keep themselves informed about the day-to-day instructions given in the schools. A plea of ignorance of any rule cannot be accepted as an excuse for breaking it.
- 2. Students are expected to be in decorum and to pay due respect to the faculty and other school officials. Every member of the staff has authority to forbid disorderly behaviour in the school.
- 3. Disorderly behaviour, loitering or congregating in the corridor, being source of disturbance and annoyance to others is not permitted.
- 4. Later arrival and early departure at / or from the school are recorded as absence from the school.
- 5. It is misdemeanour to interfere with any apparatus or enter any lab / room other than directed.
- Tools and other machinery must be left in good order after use. If damaged, the fact must be immediately reported.
- 7. The students at the school require attention and diligence. A student neglecting his studies and showing un-satisfactory progress will be given two warnings, after which, if he fails to improve, will be liable for expulsion from school.
- 8. Students shall observe all safety

- precautions. The school shall not be responsible for accident of whatsoever nature in the school / workshop / play ground/work place. The school shall not be responsible for any untoward incident while commuting between home to school and school to home and to any place of training.
- 9. Students are not allowed to use mobiles in the school campus. Action will be taken against the defaulters.
- 10. Conduct inconsistent wit general school rules or persistent neglect of work or failure to respond promptly to official notice may be punished with levy of fines and even expulsion from the school in the interest of general discipline by the Principal.
- 11. Instructions/Guidelines relating to a specific skill course given in the course of studies issued by CBSE or any other subsequent instructions/guidelines/rules and regulations circulated by the authorities concerned are to be strictly followed.
- 12. The students are required to come to school in proper uniform as prescribed by the Education Department, Chandigarh Administration.
- 13. Parents can meet the teachers on the last Saturday of every month. However, school can decide any other convenient day.
- 14. Rules for change of subject(s):
- a. No candidate shall be permitted to change his/her subjects of studies after passing Class XI.
- b. The candidate shall not offer a

- subject in Class XII, which he/she has not studied and passed in Class XI.
- c. Head of the school may allow change in subject in Class XI but not later than 31st October of the academic session.
- d. The change of subject (s)/stream has been allowed by CBSE to the failures of Class XII. However, this change shall be permissible only from Science to Commerce or Humanities streams and not vice versa.
- e. Not withstanding the above, the chairman of CBSE has the power to allow a candidate to appear in any subject he thinks desirable under exceptional circumstances.
- f. No student shall be eligible to take the examination unless he has completed 75% of attendance counted from the beginning of Class XI/XII up to the 1st of the month preceding the month of annual examination.

Nature of Examination:

- 1. In order to orient the students towards competitive examination, MCQ tests are held regularly at the school level. Class XI examination shall be conducted internally by the schools themselves while Class XII examination based on the syllabus for Class XII only shall be conducted by the CBSE according to the following schemes:
- a. The Board shall conduct examination in all subjects except General Studies/Personality Development and Soft Skills, Work Experience,

- Physical and Health Education, which will be assessed internally by the school.
- b. In the subject examined by the Board a student will be given one paper each carrying 100 marks for 3 hours. However, in subject requiring practical examination there will be a theory paper and a practical examination as required in the course of studies.
- c. In Work Experience, General Studies/Personality Development and Soft Skills and Physical and Health Education, schools are required to maintain cumulative record of continuous evaluation of students' achievements and progress. The record is subject to scrutiny by the Board as and when it deems necessary.
- d. A candidate from a recognized school, having physical deformity or otherwise unable to take part in Work Experience and Physical and Health Education, may be granted exemption by the Chairman of the Board, on the recommendation of the Head of the School, supported by Medical Certificate from the Medical Officer of the rank not below an Assistant Surgeon.
- e. A candidate may offer an additional subject which can be either a language at elective level or another elective subject as prescribed in the scheme of studies, subject to the conditions laid down in the Pass Criteria.

Scheme of Examination...

Terminal Examination:

- 1. The terminal examination will be held in the month of October besides two unit tests which would be held between the months of November to January.
- 2. Annual examination shall be held in the month of March. In case of Board Examination, it shall depend on the directions of the CBSE.
- 3. A student taking Skill Course will also undergo on-the-job training. Instructions of the Department are to be adhered to in this regard.
- 4. All types of State and Centre Scholarships are tenable in all Senior Secondary Schools. There is no tuition fee for male students belonging to Scheduled Castes/Tribes. However, Scholarships/Stipends of all the categories are liable to be withdrawn if a student remains irregular in attendance or is found guilty of misbehaviour or shows unsatisfactory progress in studies.

N.S.S.

N.S.S. has been introduced in some of the Senior Secondary Schools to instil in young students the idea of community service. N.S.S. provides the opportunity to student volunteers to understand the social environment in which they live and also to gain skill in programme development.

Library

Library facilities are provided in all Senior Secondary Schools of Chandigarh for students to avail opportunities for self reading.

Guiance and Counselling:
